

COMMITTEE REPORT

MR. PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Health and Environmental Affairs, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 215, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 3, between lines 15 and 16, begin a new paragraph and
2 insert:
3 "SECTION 4. P.L.40-1994, SECTION 87, IS AMENDED TO
4 READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: SECTION
5 87. (a) As used in this SECTION, "committee" refers to the Central
6 State advisory committee established by subsection (b).
7 (b) The Central State advisory committee is established.
8 (c) The committee consists of the following members:
9 (1) Four (4) members of the senate appointed by the president
10 pro tempore of the senate. Not more than two (2) members
11 appointed under this subdivision may be members of the same
12 political party. The members under this subdivision must be
13 appointed so that the following are satisfied:
14 (A) The senator in whose district Central State Hospital is
15 located must be a member of the committee.
16 (B) A senator who serves on the senate committee
17 concerned with financial matters must be a member of the
18 committee.
19 (C) A senator who serves on the senate committee
20 concerned with health matters must be a member of the

- 1 committee.
- 2 (2) Four (4) members of the house of representatives appointed
3 by the speaker of the house of representatives. Not more than
4 two (2) members appointed under this subdivision may be
5 members of the same political party. The members under this
6 subdivision must be appointed so that the following are satisfied:
- 7 (A) The representative in whose district Central State
8 Hospital is located must be a member of the committee.
- 9 (B) A representative who serves on the house committee
10 concerned with financial matters must be a member of the
11 committee.
- 12 (C) A representative who serves on the house committee
13 concerned with health matters must be a member of the
14 committee.
- 15 (d) The president pro tempore of the senate shall appoint the chair
16 of the committee. After the chair of the committee is appointed, the
17 speaker of the house of representatives shall appoint the vice chair of
18 the committee. The chair and the vice chair of the committee may not
19 be members of the same political party.
- 20 (e) The committee shall meet at the call of the chair.
- 21 (f) The affirmative vote of five (5) members of the committee is
22 necessary for the committee to take any action other than to meet to
23 take testimony or to adjourn.
- 24 (g) Each member of the committee is entitled to receive the same
25 per diem, mileage, and travel allowances paid to individuals serving as
26 legislative members on interim study committees established by the
27 legislative council.
- 28 (h) This subsection does not apply to a transaction or the renewal
29 of a transaction if the transaction was entered into before January 1,
30 1994. Before the state may:
- 31 (1) sell, lease, or transfer possession of any part of the real
32 property constituting the grounds of Central State Hospital; or
33 (2) enter into an agreement for any transaction described in
34 subdivision (1);
- 35 the governor must submit to the committee a detailed report describing
36 the proposed transaction and the reasons for the proposed transaction.
37 Upon receiving a report under this subsection, the chair of the
38 committee shall call a meeting of the committee to act upon the report.

1 The committee shall act upon the report within sixty (60) days of
2 submission by the governor. The state may not proceed with the
3 transaction until the governor responds to the committee's
4 recommendation.

5 (i) The committee shall operate under policies and procedures
6 established by the legislative council.

7 (j) This SECTION expires ~~January~~ **July 1, 1999: 2001.**"

8 Page 4, between lines 12 and 13, begin a new paragraph and
9 insert:

10 "SECTION 7. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] **(a) Not later**
11 **than July 1, 2000, the division of mental health established by**
12 **IC 12-21-1-1 shall provide a written report to the legislative council**
13 **that provides specific details regarding the division's plans for**
14 **reestablishing patient care for adult individuals with mental illness**
15 **at the site of Central State Hospital as required by IC 12-14-1-8, as**
16 **added by this act.**

17 **(b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2001.**"

18 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.

(Reference is to SB 215 as introduced.)
