

COMMITTEE REPORT

MR. PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Corrections, Criminal and Civil Procedures, to which was referred House Bill No. 1036, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Delete the amendment made on motion of Representative Kruzan
- 2 adopted January 22, 1998.
- 3 Page 1, line 6, delete "Class C" and insert "**Class D**".
- 4 Page 1, between lines 11 and 12, begin a new paragraph and
- 5 insert:
- 6 "SECTION 2. IC 9-19-10-3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 7 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 3. **A vehicle may be**
- 8 **stopped to determine compliance with this chapter. However, a**
- 9 **person vehicle, the contents of a vehicle, the driver of a vehicle, or**
- 10 **a passenger in a vehicle** may not be ~~stopped~~, inspected, searched, or
- 11 detained solely to determine compliance with ~~because of a violation~~
- 12 **of this chapter.**".

1 Page 2, line 6, after "a" insert "~~Class C~~".

2 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
