MR. PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Health and Environmental Affairs, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 212, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 2, line 5, delete ";" and insert ":".
- 2 Page 2, line 5, delete ":".
- 3 Page 2, reset in roman lines 6 through 10.
- 4 Page 2, line 6, strike "includes" and insert "**including**".
- 5 Page 2, line 9, strike "does".
- 6 Page 2, line 9, strike "include" and insert "**including**".
- 7 Page 2, line 13, reset in roman "or".
- 8 Page 2, line 16, delete "or".
- 9 Page 2, delete lines 17 through 25.
- 10 Page 3, between lines 3 and 4, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 11 "SECTION 2. IC 25-22.5-8-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 12 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 2. (a) A person who
- 13 violates this article by unlawfully practicing medicine or osteopathic
- 14 medicine commits a Class C felony.
- 15 (b) ~~A person who practices midwifery without the license required~~
- 16 ~~under this article commits a Class D felony.~~
- 17 (c) A person who acts as a physician's assistant without registering

- 1 with the board as required under this article commits a Class D
- 2 felony.".
- 3 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
(Reference is to SB 212 as introduced.)
