

# COMMITTEE REPORT

## MR. PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Rules and Legislative Procedure, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 474, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be amended as follows:

- Delete the title and insert the following:
- "A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law."
- Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert the following:
- "SECTION 1. IC 35-46-1-11.3, AS ADDED BY P.L.256-1996, SECTION 12, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 11.3. (a) This section does not apply to advertisements posted:
  - ~~(1) at street level on the exterior of a business establishment where tobacco products are manufactured, distributed, or sold;~~
  - ~~or~~
  - ~~(2) on vehicles.~~
- (b) After December 31, ~~1996~~, **1998**, a person may not advertise or cause to be advertised tobacco products ~~on a billboard located within two hundred (200)~~ **one thousand (1,000) feet of the following:**
  - (1) a public or private elementary or secondary school, as measured between the nearest point of:**
    - (A) the billboard advertisement; and the nearest point of**
    - (B) a building used by the school for instructional purposes.**
  - (2) A day care center licensed under IC 12-17.2.**
  - (3) A park or playground controlled by a political subdivision (as defined in IC 6-1.1-1-12).**
- (c) A person who violates this section commits a Class C misdemeanor."

(Reference is to SB 474 as introduced.)

**and when so amended that said bill be reassigned to the Senate Committee on Governmental and Regulatory Affairs.**
