HOUSE BILL No. 1014**

DIGEST OF HB 1014 (Updated March 23, 1999 12:25 pm - DI 71)

Citations Affected: IC 25-6.1.

Synopsis: Continuing education for auctioneers. Removes provision prohibiting an individual from performing an act that requires an auctioneer license when the individual has been granted a waiver from the continuing education requirement for license renewal.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1014

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning professions and occupations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 25-6.1-9-9 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 9. (a) The commission
3 may grant an applicant a waiver from all or part of the continuing
4 education requirement for the renewal period if the applicant was not
5 able to fulfill the requirement due to a hardship that resulted from any
6 of the following conditions:
7 (1) Service in the armed forces of the United States during a
8 substantial part of the renewal period.
9 (2) An incapacitating illness or injury.
10 (3) Other circumstances determined by the commission.

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HOUSE MOTION

Mr. Speaker: I move that House Bill 1014 be amended to read as follows:

Page 1, after line 14, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 2. IC 25-8-15-9 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS: Sec. 9. (a) A cosmetology professional may apply in writing to the board for a waiver or modification of the continuing education requirements if the cosmetology professional:

- (1) establishes that an emergency existed during the period for which the continuing education was required;
- (2) has had an incapacitating illness verified by the applicant and a licensed physician;
- (3) is licensed in another state that requires at least sixteen (16) hours of continuing education, and the cosmetology professional submits written verification to the board of compliance with the requirements of the other state; ~~or~~
- (4) was prevented from completing the continuing education requirement because of active military duty during the period for which the continuing education was required; ~~or~~
- (5) has completed twelve (12) years of service as a cosmetology professional.**

(b) **Except as provided in subsection (c), a** ~~A~~ waiver granted by the board for an emergency, an illness, or military service of less than one (1) year shall state that the continuing education requirement is cumulative and that the required education must be completed and satisfactory proof of completion must be filed with the board before the license may be renewed. All other waivers must contain a continuing education requirement as determined by the board on a waiver by waiver basis and must state that the required education must be completed and satisfactory proof of completion of the required education must be filed with the board before the license may be renewed.

(c) A waiver granted for a person who has completed twelve (12) years of service as a cosmetology professional shall state that no further continuing education is required."
