DIGEST OF HB 1163 (Updated March 15, 1999 4:21 pm - DI 78)

Citations Affected: IC 13-20; IC 36-9.

Synopsis: Indiana institute on recycling. Extends the Indiana institute on recycling to June 30, 2001. (Under current law, the institute will terminate June 30, 1999.) Repeals a statute that requires counties, municipalities, and townships to report certain information to the Indiana institute on recycling about solid waste collection and disposal costs.

Effective: Upon passage; July 1, 1999.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1163

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning environmental law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 13-20-18-11 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 11. The institute
3 terminates June 30, ~~1999~~. **2001**.

4 SECTION 2. IC 13-20-18-12 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
5 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 12. This chapter
6 expires June 30, ~~1999~~. **2001**.

7 SECTION 3. IC 36-9-30-36 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY 1,
8 1999].

9 SECTION 4. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
