ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1230

DIGEST OF HB 1230 (Updated March 24, 1999 6:34 pm - DI 47)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Mutual insurance company study. Establishes a two year interim committee to study mutual insurance companies. Requires the committee to conduct meetings and to issue a final report of its findings and recommendations to the legislative council not later than November 1, 2000. Provides that the committee is under the jurisdiction of the legislative council. Requires the legislative services agency to provide staff and administrative support for the committee.

Effective: May 15, 1999.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1230

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning insurance.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE MAY 15, 1999] (a) **The mutual**
2 **insurance company study committee (referred to as "the**
3 **committee" in this SECTION) is established.**
4 (b) **The committee shall study the law concerning mutual**
5 **insurance companies and proposals to change that law. The**
6 **committee may study other topics:**
7 (1) **as assigned by the legislative council; or**
8 (2) **as directed by the chairman of the committee.**
9 (c) **The committee consists of twelve (12) members of the**
10 **general assembly, appointed as follows:**
11 (1) **The speaker of the house of representatives, with the**
12 **advice of the minority leader of the house of representatives,**
13 **shall appoint six (6) members of the house of representatives,**
14 **not more than three (3) of whom are members of the same**
15 **political party.**
16 (2) **The president pro tempore of the senate, with the advice**
17 **of the minority leader of the senate, shall appoint six (6)**

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1 members of the senate, not more than three (3) of whom are
2 members of the same political party.

3 (d) At the time the committee members are appointed in 1999,
4 the chairman of the legislative council shall name one (1) of the
5 members chairman and the vice-chairman of the legislative council
6 shall name another member vice chairman. The terms of the
7 chairman and vice chairman appointed under this subsection begin
8 June 1, 1999, and terminate March 15, 2000.

9 (e) After January 1, 2000, the chairman of the legislative council
10 shall name one (1) of the members chairman and the vice-chairman
11 of the legislative council shall name another member vice
12 chairman. The terms of the chairman and vice chairman appointed
13 under this subsection begin March 16, 2000, and terminate
14 December 1, 2000.

15 (f) The initial appointments to the committee shall be made
16 before June 1, 1999. The appointments are for a term expiring
17 December 1, 2000. A vacancy shall be filled through the
18 appointment of a replacement by the appointing authority.

19 (g) To carry out its duties under this SECTION, the committee
20 shall do the following:

21 (1) Conduct meetings to hear the concerns of citizens of
22 Indiana and obtain advice from interested professionals.

23 (2) Issue a final report of its findings and recommendations to
24 the legislative council not later than November 1, 2000.

25 (h) The committee shall meet at the call of the chairman.

26 (i) Each member of the committee is entitled to receive the same
27 per diem, mileage, and travel allowance paid to members of the
28 general assembly serving on interim study committees established
29 by the legislative council.

30 (j) The committee is under the jurisdiction of the legislative
31 council and shall operate under policies and procedures established
32 by the legislative council.

33 (k) The affirmative votes of a majority of the members
34 appointed to the committee are required for the committee to take
35 action on any measure, including final reports.

36 (l) The legislative services agency shall provide staff and
37 administrative support for the committee.

38 (m) This SECTION expires December 1, 2000.

39 SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
