DIGEST OF HB 1386 (Updated March 29, 1999 11:22 am - DI 77)

Citations Affected: IC 14-22.

Synopsis: Fishing license exemption. Exempts a developmentally disabled person from the requirement to have a fishing license if the person: (1) is a resident of Indiana; and (2) is fishing with a person who holds a fishing license.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1386

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 14-22-11-8 IS AMENDED TO READ AS

12 IC 16-18-2-167) licensed in Indiana; and
13 (B) taking part in a supervised activity of the health facility.
