# ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1396

DIGEST OF HB 1396 (Updated April 1, 1999 8:18 am - DI 88)

**Citations Affected:** Noncode.

**Synopsis:** Medicaid outpatient mental health reimbursement. Requires the office of the secretary of family and social services to amend a rule to include certain school psychologists and advanced practice nurses as providers of Medicaid reimbursable physician or health service provider in psychology directed outpatient mental health services for group, family, and individual outpatient mental health services, subject to rules governing prior authorization and supervision. Requires the office of the secretary of family and social services to include certain school psychologists and advanced practice nurses as qualified mental health professionals under a rule regulating community mental health rehabilitation services.

**Effective:** Upon passage.

## ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1396

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning human services.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **Before January**  
2 **1, 2000, the office of the secretary of family and social services shall**  
3 **amend 405 IAC 5-20-8(1) and 405 IAC 5-21-1(c) to include:**  
4 (1) **school psychologists who have an endorsement as an**  
5 **independent practice school psychologist under IC 20-1-1.9;**  
6 **and**  
7 (2) **advanced practice nurses under IC 25-23-1-1(b)(3) who**  
8 **are credentialed in psychiatric or mental health nursing by**  
9 **the American Nurses Credentialing Center;**  
10 **as providers of Medicaid reimbursable physician or health service**  
11 **provider in psychology (licensed under IC 25-33-1-5.1) directed**  
12 **outpatient mental health services for group, family, and individual**  
13 **outpatient mental health services, subject to rules governing prior**  
14 **authorization and supervision.**  
15 (b) **This SECTION expires January 1, 2000.**  
16 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
