DIGEST OF HB 1576 (Updated March 30, 1999 12:59 pm - DI 71)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Indiana youth development committee. Establishes the Indiana youth development charter committee of the state human resources investment council to collect data and provide recommendations regarding the availability of youth development services. Requires the committee to submit interim reports to the governor and legislative council before November 1, 1999, and November 1, 2000, and a final report before November 1, 2001.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1576

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning family law and juvenile law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999] (a) As used in this
2 SECTION, "committee" refers to the Indiana youth development
3 charter committee of the state human resources investment council
4 established by this SECTION.
5 (b) As used in this SECTION, "youth" means an individual less
6 than nineteen (19) years of age.
7 (c) The Indiana youth development charter committee of the
8 state human resources investment council is established.
9 (d) The committee consists of the following members:
10 (1) Two (2) individuals appointed by the speaker of the house
11 of representatives. The individuals appointed under this
12 subdivision may not be members of the same political party.
13 (2) Two (2) individuals appointed by the president pro
14 tempore of the senate. The individuals appointed under this
15 subdivision may not be members of the same political party.
16 (3) Six (6) individuals appointed by the governor who are
17 representatives of nonprofit organizations that:
18 (A) have a statewide presence; and

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- 1 **(B) provide:**
 2 (i) development;
 3 (ii) prevention; or
 4 (iii) intervention;
 5 services to youths.
 6 **(4) Two (2) individuals who are members of the state human**
 7 **resources investment council representing business and**
 8 **industry, to be appointed by the chairperson of the state**
 9 **human resources investment council.**
 10 **(5) Two (2) individuals who are members of the state human**
 11 **resources investment council representing labor, community**
 12 **organizations, and special populations, to be appointed by the**
 13 **chairperson of the state human resources investment council.**
 14 **(6) Two (2) individuals who are members of the state human**
 15 **resources investment council representing education and local**
 16 **government, to be appointed by the chairperson of the state**
 17 **human resources investment council.**
 18 **(7) Two (2) individuals who are youths appointed by the**
 19 **Indiana commission on community services and volunteerism**
 20 **established by executive order 97-11.**
 21 **(8) Additional individuals as determined necessary by the**
 22 **committee's chairperson to complete the committee's work.**
 23 **(9) The secretary of family and social services or the**
 24 **secretary's designee.**
 25 **(10) The commissioner of the department of correction or the**
 26 **commissioner's designee.**
 27 **The committee members described in subdivisions (8), (9), and (10)**
 28 **are nonvoting members of the committee. The appointing authority**
 29 **shall make the appointments required by this subsection before**
 30 **August 15, 1999. The appointing authority shall fill any vacancy in**
 31 **these positions within forty-five (45) days. If an appointed member**
 32 **is unable to fulfill the appointed member's commitment to the**
 33 **committee or when a vacancy occurs on the committee for any**
 34 **reason, the appointing authority may appoint a qualified person to**
 35 **fill the remainder of the vacating member's unexpired term.**
 36 **(e) The governor shall appoint a member of the committee to**
 37 **serve as chairperson of the committee. The member serves as**
 38 **chairperson at the pleasure of the governor.**
 39 **(f) Each member of the committee who is not a state employee**
 40 **is entitled to the minimum salary per diem provided by**
 41 **IC 4-10-11-2.1(b). The member is also entitled to reimbursement**
 42 **for traveling expenses as provided under IC 4-13-1-4 and other**



1 expenses actually incurred in connection with the member's duties
 2 as provided in the state policies and procedures established by the
 3 Indiana department of administration and approved by the budget
 4 agency.

5 (g) Each member of the committee who is a state employee but
 6 who is not a member of the general assembly is entitled to
 7 reimbursement for traveling expenses as provided under
 8 IC 4-13-1-4 and other expenses actually incurred in connection
 9 with the member's duties as provided in the state policies and
 10 procedures established by the Indiana department of
 11 administration and approved by the budget agency.

12 (h) Each member of the committee who is a member of the
 13 general assembly is entitled to receive the same per diem, mileage,
 14 and travel allowances paid to members of the general assembly
 15 serving on interim study committees established by the legislative
 16 council.

17 (i) The state human resource investment council shall provide
 18 staff support to the committee in collaboration with the office of
 19 the secretary of family and social services and the divisions
 20 described in IC 12-7-2-69(a).

21 (j) The committee shall do the following:

22 (1) Consider problems affecting youths and recommend
 23 solutions or approaches to the problems to state and local
 24 government officials.

25 (2) Promote youth development activities that ensure that
 26 youths thrive and become competent, useful, and empowered
 27 and develop a sense of belonging.

28 (3) Be diverse in representation.

29 (4) Develop guidelines for the establishment of positive youth
 30 development programs based on a consideration of the
 31 following:

32 (A) Individual and community capacity for change.

33 (B) Community structures and resources that enhance
 34 supports of and opportunities for youth development.

35 (C) Barriers to access to supports and opportunities for
 36 youths.

37 (D) Outcomes of current youth development programs
 38 regarding youths as:

39 (i) individuals; and

40 (ii) members of their communities.

41 (5) Conduct an asset and needs assessment of current youth
 42 development programs, including governmental programs



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which promote positive youth development.

(6) Provide opportunities for youth involvement in the work performed by the committee.

(7) Review and make recommendations first to the state human resources investment council and then to the governor and legislative council regarding any unmet need for youth development programs.

(k) The committee shall meet at least eight (8) times each state fiscal year and more frequently as requested by an affirmative vote of a majority of the members appointed to the committee.

(l) The affirmative votes of a majority of the voting members of the committee are required for the committee to take action on any measure, including final reports.

(m) The committee may accept contributions to be used by the committee to carry out the duties required by this SECTION in accordance with IC 22-4-18.1-7.

(n) The committee shall submit an interim report first to the state human resources investment council and then to the governor and the legislative council before:

- (1) November 1, 1999; and
- (2) November 1, 2000.

(o) The committee shall submit its final report first to the state human resources investment council and then to the governor and the legislative council before November 1, 2001.

(p) This SECTION expires December 31, 2001.
