DIGEST OF HB1618 (Updated March 17, 1999 6:33 pm - DI 87)

Citations Affected: IC 5-11.

Synopsis: Unpaid checks and warrants drawn on public funds. Provides that warrants or checks drawn upon public funds of a political subdivision are void, rather than canceled, if outstanding and unpaid for at least two years.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1618

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 5-11-10.5-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 2. All warrants or
3 checks drawn upon public funds of a political subdivision that are
4 outstanding and unpaid for a period of two (2) or more years as of the
5 last day of December of each year are ~~cancelled~~ **void**. No individual,
6 bank, trust company, building and loan association, or any other
7 financial institution may honor, cash, or accept for payment or deposit
8 any such warrant or check which may be presented for payment and
9 which has been issued and outstanding for a period of two (2) or more
10 years as of the last day of December of any year.

11 SECTION 2. IC 5-11-10.5-6 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY
12 1, 1999].
