Citations Affected: IC 20-12.

Synopsis: Purdue and Indiana University trustees. Removes the requirement that a trustee of Purdue University or Indiana University elected by the alumni must be a resident of Indiana.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1672

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-12-24-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 2. (a) Three (3)
3 members of the board of trustees shall be elected by the alumni of the
4 university in the manner provided in this chapter. In the year in which
5 the term of any member of the board of trustees elected by the alumni
6 will expire, a successor to such trustee shall be elected by the alumni
7 of the university, to serve for a term of three (3) years from the first day
8 of July next succeeding the election. When a vacancy occurs in the
9 membership of the board of trustees who are elected by the alumni,
10 because of death, resignation, ~~removal from the state~~, or any other
11 reason, such vacancy shall be filled by election by the alumni, for the
12 unexpired term."

13 (b) The members of the board of trustees who are elected under this
14 section must be alumni of the university.

15 SECTION 2. IC 20-12-37-3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
16 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 3. Three (3) of the

1 trustees so appointed shall be selected by the members of the Purdue
2 alumni association, one of whom shall be a graduate of the school of
3 agriculture, at the annual meeting of such association for the year
4 1920-1921, to be held prior to July 1, 1921, one of such trustees so
5 selected shall serve for one (1) year; one for two (2) years and one for
6 three (3) years; all of such trustees so selected shall be members of the
7 alumni association and graduates of Purdue University. ~~and reside in~~
8 ~~the state of Indiana.~~ The qualifications thus prescribed shall apply to all
9 subsequent selections. At the annual meeting of the Purdue alumni
10 association for the year in which the term of office of any one of the
11 said alumni trustees expires, a successor shall be selected by the
12 members of the Purdue alumni association, in such manner as such
13 association may prescribe. The president of such association shall
14 certify all selections so made by such Purdue alumni association and
15 the respective terms of such persons so selected, and the persons so
16 selected shall, by the governor, be appointed to serve for the respective
17 periods for which such persons were so selected. If, at any time, a
18 vacancy shall occur on the board of trustees, occasioned by the death,
19 resignation, ~~removal from the state,~~ expiration of term, or otherwise, of
20 any of the trustees selected by the members of the Purdue alumni
21 association, such vacancy shall be filled by selection by the president
22 of such alumni association, to serve until the next annual meeting of
23 such alumni association, when a successor to fill out the unexpired
24 term shall be selected as herein provided, and such person so selected
25 shall be appointed by the governor to fill out such unexpired term.

COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. President: The Senate Committee on Education, to which was referred House Bill No. 1672, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 1. IC 20-12-24-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 2. (a) Three (3) members of the board of trustees shall be elected by the alumni of the university in the manner provided in this chapter. In the year in which the term of any member of the board of trustees elected by the alumni will expire, a successor to such trustee shall be elected by the alumni of the university, to serve for a term of three (3) years from the first day of July next succeeding the election. When a vacancy occurs in the membership of the board of trustees who are elected by the alumni, because of death, resignation, ~~removal from the state~~, or any other reason, such vacancy shall be filled by election by the alumni, for the unexpired term."

(b) The members of the board of trustees who are elected under this section must be alumni of the university."

Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
