**Summary of Legislation:** (Amended) This bill removes the provision prohibiting an individual from performing an act that requires an auctioneer license when the individual has been granted a waiver from the continuing education requirement for license renewal. It also allows a cosmetology professional to apply to the State Board of Cosmetology Examiners for a waiver or modification of the Board's continuing education requirements if the cosmetology professional has completed 12 years of service as a cosmetology professional. The bill requires that a waiver granted to a cosmetology professional who has completed 12 years of service must state that no further continuing education is required of the cosmetology professional.
