Summary of Legislation: This bill provides that the Worker's Compensation and Occupational Diseases Law applies to seamen on certain excursion boats for injuries and disablements occurring after June 30, 1999. The bill also provides that payments made under the federal Jones Act to a disabled seaman shall be deducted from the total amount paid to the seaman under the Worker's Compensation and Occupational Diseases Law.
