Summary of Legislation: This bill prohibits a court from granting visitation rights with a child to a parent who has been convicted of murder of the child's other parent unless the court finds that: (1) the statutory requirements entitling a parent to reasonable visitation under current law are met; (2) the child is of a reasonable age to agree to the visitation; and (3) the child consents to the visitation.
