Summary of Legislation: This bill establishes the Indiana Advisory Council on Secondary School Activities. It provides membership and responsibilities for the Council. It provides that the Indiana High School Athletic Association (IHSAA) board of directors must include principals, athletic directors, and coaches with certain qualifications. It provides that a school in a school corporation may not be a member of or pay money to the association for any purpose unless the board of directors of the association complies with certain requirements concerning the Advisory Council and membership of the Association board.

Explanation of Local Expenditures: Members of this council would receive neither a per diem nor compensation for service on the council. If the IHSAA does not comply with the provisions in this bill, then schools in a school corporation would not be permitted to pay any dues or other contributions to the Indiana High School Athletic Association. Consequently, it is possible that passage of this bill could reduce some expenditures to school corporations if they are legally prohibited from paying dues to the IHSAA.
