Summary of Legislation: This bill exempts a special group recognition license plate issued for a survivor of the attack on Pearl Harbor from minimum license plate sales requirements.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Revenues: There were 136 Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates sold in 1997. There is administrative fee of \$12 charged for each plate. Revenue from these plates is split evenly between the State License Branch Fund which supports the license branches and the Motor Vehicle Highway Account which supports the BMV.
