SUBJECT: Department of Correction drug formulary.

Summary of Legislation: This bill requires the Department of Correction (DOC) to: (1) develop and review any drug formulary it uses for the treatment of mental illness; and (2) have policies and procedures that provide exceptions to the formulary. (The introduced version of this bill was prepared by the Indiana Commission on Mental Health.)

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: This bill would require DOC staff to meet with Division of Mental Health staff at least annually to discuss and revise DOC's existing drug formulary concerning drugs with efficacy in the treatment of mental illness. Currently, the DOC Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee meets quarterly. Minimal administrative and staffing expenses will occur in the implementation of this bill.
