Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill provides that if the Department of Correction or a contractor of the Department provides prescription drugs to offenders through a drug program, the program must be developed and reviewed in consultation with a Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee. It also provides that the drug program may use the Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning Drug Utilization Board to fulfill its duties. (The introduced version of this bill was prepared by the Indiana Commission on Mental Health.)

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: (Revised) This bill would require DOC staff to meet with a Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee with statutorily defined members. (DOC staff currently meets quarterly with such a committee regarding drug applications.) Negligible administrative and staffing expenses will occur in the implementation of this bill.

The Drug Utilization Board, with which DOC may consult, collects data, provides information and makes recommendations regarding therapeutic drug use in the Medicaid program.
