Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill allows a manufacturer or the agent of a manufacturer of mobile homes to transport a tractor-mobile home rig from the manufacturing facility to a storage lot if the distance between the manufacturing facility and storage lot is less than 3 miles and the manufacturer or agent has obtained an annual permit from the Motor Carrier Service Division of the Department of State Revenue. The fee for the annual permit is \$40.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures:

Explanation of State Revenues: (Revised) The Department of Revenue- Motor Carrier Service Division reports that under current practice, because of the sheer volume of the number of new mobile homes, some manufacturers are transporting a tractor-mobile home rig without obtaining a trip permit. These trip permits cost \$10 or \$18 per trip and take several days to process. This bill creates an annual permit to provide ease of permitting. The specific revenue will depend upon the number of permits issued. Currently, there are 41 manufacturers of mobile homes in Indiana. The fund affected is the State Highway Fund.
