Summary of Legislation: This bill requires an applicant to provide the last four digits of the applicant's Social Security number on a voter registration form.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: Currently the voter registration form requests the Social Security number of an individual as allowed under the federal Privacy Act of 1974 (U.S.C. 552a). A space is provided on the voter registration form for this information.

This bill requires an applicant to provide the last four digits of the applicant's Social Security number on a voter registration form. This provision will require a change in the current form. The cost of changing and printing the form can be done within the existing budget.
