**IMPACT:** State

**Summary of Legislation:** This bill allows a person registering a motor vehicle to make a donation of \$1 or more to organizations that promote the procurement of organs as anatomical gifts. (Under current law, a person registering a motor vehicle may only make a donation of \$0.50.)

**Effective Date:** January 1, 2000.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** For the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV), there likely will be an expense to make any computer/accounting changes required by the change in the donation amount. This can be absorbed within the current budget of the BMV. The revision of current registration forms to include the newly designated donor amount would be assumed under normal form revision expenses. The fund affected is the Motor Vehicle Highway Account which supports the BMV.
