Summary of Legislation: This bill provides for the designation of a section of highway in Michigan City as an extra heavy duty highway.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: Because no bridges exist on this short portion of U.S. 35, the state would not have any immediate fiscal impact. The road itself can support the extra heavy-duty loads. The only fiscal impact would be routine, ongoing preservation maintenance for the Department of Transportation.
