**Summary of Legislation:** This bill allows a sheriff to temporarily suspend a county police officer with or without pay for a period not exceeding five days without a hearing before the sheriff's merit board. (Current law allows a sheriff to temporarily suspend a county police officer with or without pay for a period not exceeding 15 days without a hearing before the sheriff's merit board.)
