**IMPACT:** Local

**Summary of Legislation:** This bill requires a court clerk to collect a proceedings supplemental fee of \$15 from a party who files a motion for proceedings supplemental to enforce a civil judgment. It also requires the clerk to forward the fee to the county auditor for deposit in the county general fund.

**Explanation of Local Revenues:** The number of redocketed cases filed each year has not been tracked since 1990. In 1990, 119,579 redocketed civil cases were filed. Based on the number of redocketed civil filings recorded annually from 1980 to 1990, it is estimated that redocketed civil cases increase by 5% each year. A 5% annual increase since 1990 yields an estimate of 176,672 redocketed cases in 1998. A \$15 supplemental fee assessed on each redocketed civil case would generate \$2.65M in annual revenue to county general funds statewide.
