Summary of Legislation: This bill exempts a special group recognition license plate issued for a college or university from minimum license plate sales requirements.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: This proposal exempts a special group recognition license plate issued for a college or university from minimum license plate sales requirements. It allows the continued issuance of this special group license plate that otherwise might be discontinued. The specific impact is indeterminable. University and colleges that would continue plate issuance under this proposal are: Butler University, DePauw University, IUPUI, Anderson College, Indiana Wesleyan, Manchester College, Marian College, Rose Hulman, Taylor University, St. Mary of the Woods College, University of Evansville, University of Indianapolis, Vincennes University, Wabash College, and Taylor University.
