Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill: 1) exempts a special group recognition license plate issued for a college or university from minimum license plate sales requirements. 2) requires the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) to issue a Vietnam Veteran License Plate.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: (Revised) Part 1 of this proposal exempts a special group recognition license plate issued for a college or university from minimum license plate sales requirements. It allows the continued issuance of this special group license plate that otherwise might be discontinued. The specific impact is indeterminable. University and colleges that would continue plate issuance under this proposal are: Butler University, DePauw University, IUPUI, Anderson College, Indiana Wesleyan, Manchester College, Marian College, Rose Hulman, Taylor University, St. Mary of the Woods College, University of Evansville, University of Indianapolis, Vincennes University, Wabash College, and Taylor University

Part 2 of this proposal requires the BMV to design and issue a Vietnam Veteran License Plate. There will be a charge from the Prison Network Enterprise (PEN) Products, the manufacturing and marketing arm of prison made products of \$2.60 per plate for the newly created license plate. These charges are to the BMV. The funds affected are PEN Products Revolving Fund and the Motor Vehicle Highway Account which supports the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV). In addition, the BMV could encounter some additional workload or costs involved in the design and set-up of the new plates, however, these costs can be handled within their existing budget.

Explanation of State Revenues: The proposal exempts the newly created license plate from the \$12 administrative fee and does not provide for any other fee.
