Summary of Legislation: This bill provides that a practitioner of chiropractic, optometry, or podiatry is eligible for privileges to provide patient care at a county hospital. The bill allows the hospital's governing board to establish certain standards and rules to govern a practitioner's practice in the hospital and the granting and retention of a practitioner's privileges. It allows a practitioner to appear before a peer review committee before being granted privileges and to have a hearing before a peer review committee before the practitioner's privileges are terminated. It exempts from civil liability the professional review activities of a peer review committee that are made in good faith.
