**Summary of Legislation:** This bill establishes the Homeless Issues Study Commission to study the feasibility of establishing shelters for the homeless and the extent to which under funding has exacerbated the problem of homelessness.

**Effective Date:** Upon passage.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** This bill creates the Homeless Issues Study Commission which consists of 8 legislators and 4 lay members who are entitled to per diem and travel reimbursement. Current Legislative Council Resolution allows for a budget of \$9,000 for an interim study committee.

The Legislative Services Agency is required to provide staff for the Commission.
