Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill specifies that the requirement that intrastate motor carriers that are not operating under authority issued by the United States Department of Transportation must register with the Department of State Revenue as an intrastate motor carrier does not apply to an intrastate motor carrier or a guest operator operating motor vehicle as a farm vehicle in connection with agricultural pursuits usual and normal to the user's farming operation or for personal purposes, but not operated either part time or incidentally in the conduct of a commercial enterprise. It authorizes the Department of State Revenue or the State Police Department to revoke and confiscate registrations, license plates, and cab cards of motor carriers that are subject to an operations out of service order issued by a federal agency.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: The amendment of 3/25/99 may result in additional administrative costs associated with the revocation and confiscation of registrations, license plates and cab cards. These costs are expected to be minimal at best and can be absorbed within the current budgets of the Department of Revenue and the State Police Department. The funds affected for the State Department of Revenue is the Motor Carrier Regulation Fund. The funds affected for the State Police Department are the State General Fund, the Motor Vehicle Highway Account, and the Motor Carrier Regulation Fund.
