**Summary of Legislation:** This bill amends the definition of "regulated place of amusement or entertainment" under the fire safety, building, and equipment law.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 1999.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** Changing the definition of "regulated place of amusement or entertainment" is indeterminable but could have a minimal fiscal impact. Currently, there is no information kept regarding occupancy for the inspections of regulated places of amusement or entertainment conducted by the Office of the State Fire Marshal. Any additional expenditures resulting from the provision of this bill can be done within the existing budget of the Fire and Building Services Fund, a dedicated fund.
