Summary of Legislation: This bill appropriates \$6,500,000 for the biennium to the City of Gary for the cost of extending water service to all residential areas of the city.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: This bill appropriates from the state General Fund, \$6,500,000 for the biennium. The money is appropriated to the City of Gary for the purpose of paying the costs of extending water service to the residential areas of the City.
