Summary of Legislation: This bill requires a law enforcement agency that accepts an application for a handgun license to provide, before the application is forwarded to the Superintendent, the applicant with information concerning handgun safety provided to the law enforcement agency by the Superintendent of the State Police Department.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: Based on an initial printing of approximately 200,000 brochures, it is estimated that the first year costs of producing brochures would be from \$4,800 to \$5,900, depending on color choice. Replacement of brochures thereafter would be somewhat less. Funding for the Indiana State Police originates from the state General Fund and the Motor Vehicle Highway Fund.
