**Summary of Legislation:** This bill establishes the Indiana Youth Development Study Commission to collect data and provide recommendations regarding the availability of youth development services. The bill requires the Commission to submit an initial report to the Governor and General Assembly before December 1, 1999, and a final report before July 1, 2001.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 1999.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** This bill establishes a 14 member Indiana Youth Development Study Commission consisting of 4 legislators and 12 lay members. The bill requires the Chairman of the Legislative Council to designate a legislator as the chair of the Commission. The bill provides for per diem and travel reimbursement of Commission members. Current Legislative Council Resolution sets a \$9,000 budget for Commission of less than 16 members. The Division of Family and Children is required to staff the Commission. The bill allows the Commission to accept contributions to help pay for the Commission duties.
