Summary of Legislation: Creates the pharmaceutical assistance for the aged and disabled program. Allows an Indiana resident who is eligible for the program to pay a ten dollar copayment for various prescription drugs. Provides the division of disability, aging, and rehabilitative services with the authority to restrict the supply of prescription drugs under certain circumstances. Requires a pharmacy to provide prescription price information to the division before a pharmacy may be paid for a prescription claim. Requires the division of disability, aging, and rehabilitative services to submit an annual report that contains an evaluation of the program to the general assembly. Establishes penalties for violations of the program.
