Summary of Legislation: This bill requires an individual who is an architect registered in another jurisdiction to meet the requirements placed on an architect who is a resident of Indiana before the individual may obtain a certificate of registration as a registered architect.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: The Professional Licensing Agency provides administrative support for the state regulation of architects. The Agency may experience some administrative increases as a result of this proposal; however, the expenses are not expected to be significant. The primary expenses will involve modifying rules, if necessary, to reflect the changes and notifying the public. The Agency should be able to absorb these expenses given its current budget.

Explanation of State Revenues: The above proposal could have a minimal effect on the number of individuals who apply for registration. The overall impact is not expected to be significant. Registration fees are deposited in the State General Fund.
