Summary of Legislation: This bill prohibits a state, a municipal corporation, a county, a municipality, a township, certain corporations, certain trusts, and certain other entities exempt from federal income taxation from being required to pay a fee established by the Air Pollution Control Board for a lead-based paint training program seeking approval of a lead-based paint training course.
