**IMPACT:** Local

**Summary of Legislation:** This bill provides that a paid fire department or a volunteer fire company may make a pre-planning inspection for the purpose of advising the department or company on issues affecting fire suppression response. It also provides that the fire department or volunteer fire company shall be allowed entry and access for the purpose of making a pre-planning inspection.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 1999.

**Explanation of Local Expenditures:** Under the provisions of this bill, a paid fire department or a volunteer fire company **may** make a pre-planning inspection for the purpose of advising the department or the company on issues affecting fire suppression response.
