Summary of Legislation: This bill requires state educational institutions to analyze their purchasing, construction, and contracting practices relating to minority business enterprises, small business enterprises, and women's business enterprises. It also requires each state educational institution to file a written report of the analysis with the legislative council.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: State institutions report that they have different capacities for providing the information needed to produce this report. Vincennes, IVY Tech and Ball State University report that they may need to contract with professionals that have accounting and software experience while Purdue University reports that they would be able to divert existing staff to these projects.
