Summary of Legislation: This bill appropriates \$5,000,000 to the Department of Education for distribution directly to area vocational schools for the purchase of vocational education equipment.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: Passage of this bill would appropriate \$5 million for distribution directly to the area vocational schools for purchasing vocational education equipment. The Department of Education reports 47 vocational schools across Indiana and that 93,860 students are enrolled in vocational education programs.
