Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill has the following provisions: (A) It permits a member of the commission for higher education to be a public employee if the person is not an employee or board member of a public or private university or college in Indiana. (B) It provides that the student member of the commission for higher education may be an employee of a college or university. (C) It permits members of the commission to be reimbursed for lodging expenses incurred while on official business.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: Staff at the Commission for Higher Education estimate 10 meetings per year, with 10 commission members at each meeting. At the State lodging rate of \$65 per night, the additional cost to the Commission would be \$6,500. Commission staff note that the Commission can accommodate this additional expense within existing resources.
