IMPACT: State

Summary of Legislation: This bill provides that when a police officer retires after at least 20 years service with a state university police force, the officer may retain the officer's service weapon and receive a badge showing the officer's retired status. It provides that the officer shall be issued an identification card by the department showing the officer's name and rank at retirement, retired status, and authority to retain the service weapon.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: Based upon a survey of four universities, it appears that roughly four to seven police officers would likely qualify under this statute on an annual basis. Assuming that the replacement cost of a service revolver is between \$450, the additional costs to the universities with campus police who carry service weapons would be between \$1,800 and \$3,150 per year.
