Summary of Legislation: This bill provides that a unit may regulate access to a body of water over which the unit does not have jurisdiction if the access land is within the unit's jurisdiction and the regulation is for the purpose of preventing swimming in the body of water when swimming is hazardous to personal safety.

Explanation of Local Expenditures: This bill allows a unit to regulate the access to a body water if: (1) The land that affords access to the body of water is within the territorial jurisdiction of the unit. (2)The regulation of access is for the purpose of preventing swimming n the body of water at times when swimming is hazardous to personal safety.
