Summary of Legislation: This bill allows the Department of Workforce Development to contract with a private entity to allow the private entity to provide secure electronic access to employment and wage information regarding employees.

A creditor is required to have written consent from the employee before obtaining the information.

This bill requires the private entity that contracts with the Department of Workforce Development to pay the costs of implementing and administering the program.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures:

Explanation of State Revenues: This bill allows the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) to contract with a private entity to allow the private entity to provide secure electronic access to employment and wage information regarding employees. The DWD is required to adopt rules to implement the provisions of this bill. This can be done within the existing budget and does not require an additional state General Fund appropriation.

The cost of implementing and administering the provisions of this bill will be paid by the private entity.
