**IMPACT:** Local

**Summary of Legislation:** This bill provides that a school corporation located in an area zoned by a county and annexed or incorporated by a municipality must approve a change in zoning within the school corporation district if the change in zoning is attempted by a municipality or through a municipal board of zoning appeals and the school corporation determines the change in zoning will adversely affect the school corporation population or finances.

**Explanation of Local Expenditures:** This bill requires a plan commission or the zoning board of appeals to submit a proposed zoning plan to a school corporation if the plan involves a school corporation. The school corporation must approve the proposed zoning plan before the zoning can take place. The submission and approval of the plan can be done within the existing budgets of the plan commission, zoning board of appeals and the school corporation.
