Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill provides that a municipal plan commission may adopt a comprehensive plan under the advisory planning law that includes the unincorporated area: (1) two miles from the boundaries of a municipality with a population of more than 100,000; (2) one mile from the boundaries of a municipality with a population of more than 15,000 but less than 100,000; and (3) one-half mile from the boundaries of a municipality with a population of less than 15,000.

This bill also provides that a member of the governing body of a school corporation located in an area zoned by a county and annexed or incorporated by a municipality and a member of the governing body of the county must participate in a decision to change the zoning within the school corporation district if the change in zoning is attempted by a municipality or through a municipal board of zoning appeals.
