Summary of Legislation: This bill changes the name of the Division of Mental Health to the Division of Addiction and Mental Health Services.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999; March 1, 2001.

Explanation of State Expenditures: There could be costs in changing the name on various signs especially at the state institutions under the jurisdiction of the Division of Mental Health. The only other impact would be if the Division disposed of stationery or other forms or supplies that contained the current name of the Division and replaced the supplies before it typically would.
