Summary of Legislation: This bill allows a person who registers an antique motor vehicle to furnish and display an authentic license plate or a replica license plate from the model year in which the vehicle was built or two license plates if the vehicle was built in a year during which two plates were required.

Effective Date: January 1, 2000.

Explanation of State Expenditures: For the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV), there will be computer costs for programming changes to record the necessary data to identify the owner of the antique-plated vehicle. These computer costs can be absorbed within the current BMV budget. The fund affected is the Motor Vehicle Highway Account which supports the Bureau of Motor Vehicles.
