Summary of Legislation: (CCR Amended) This bill authorizes the Indiana State Board of Nursing to license by endorsement an applicant who has completed and achieved a passing score on the English version of the Canadian Nurse Association Testing Service Examination, is currently licensed as a registered nurse in a Canadian province or another state, and meets all other requirements for receiving a license to practice as a registered nurse under Indiana law.

Effective Date: (CCR Amended) Upon passage.

Explanation of State Expenditures:

Explanation of State Revenues: (Revised) Authorizing the Indiana State Board of Nursing to license by endorsement applicants who have been licensed as registered nurses by examination under the laws of a Canadian province may increase license fee revenue by an insignificant amount. The current fee for license by endorsement is \$30, however, few individuals are expected to be affected by this proposal. All license fees collected would be deposited in the state General Fund.
