Summary of Legislation: This bill appropriates \$500,000 per year in the 1999-2001 biennium from the state General Fund to the Indiana Geological Survey to enable the Indiana Geological Survey to accelerate the process of creating geologic maps of Indiana.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: The bill appropriates \$500,000 each year for FY 2000 and FY 2001 to the Indiana Geological Survey. The survey is headed by the state geologist at Indiana University. These appropriations are made from the state General Fund to help accelerate the geologic mapping of Indiana.
